The Council of the European Union has provided non-binding guidelines for policy makers across Europe. The ten common basic principles on Roma inclusion are:

1. Constructive, pragmatic and non-discriminatory policies;
2. Explicit but not exclusive targeting;
3. Inter-cultural approach;
4. Aiming for the mainstream;
5. Awareness of the gender dimension;
6. Transfer of evidence-based policies;
7. Use of Community instruments;
8. Involvement of regional and local authorities;
9. Involvement of civil society, and
10. Active participation of the Roma.
